## International Index to Film Periodicals

**THE FOREMOST FILM JOURNALS, INDEXED** Created by the experts at the International Federation of Film Archives, this new resource indexes over 300,000 articles from 300 of the world's foremost academic and popular film journals, from 1972 onward. Records include full indexing and abstracting, with subject terms developed specifically for film studies.

**ALSO COMING SOON—PREMIUM FULL-TEXT OPTION** A companion Chadwyck-Healey offering, coming in late 2006, will add searchable full text from many of the most important FIAF journals, including full runs of key titles such as *Sight and Sound*. The full-text option will be available by subscription only.

A single search will retrieve relevant records from all these components.

**EASY ACCESS, SEARCHING, AND LINKING** Both resources will provide full search functionality, citation management support, and a My Archive feature to save searches and records between sessions. Both are OpenURL-enabled and Z39.50-enabled as well. Subscribers to the premium full-text option will receive free MARC records for the full-text titles.

FIAF is the ideal complement to these resources. It provides journal criticism of the films—American and international—indexed in the AFI Catalog and FII.
